<b>C1 — Like New</b> <b>Description</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No visible scratches, dents, chips, or discoloration</li> <li>May show extremely minor handling marks not visible at arm's length</li> <li>Appearance consistent with new or like-new equipment</li> </ul>	N CPO AIP AI AA A AX
<b>C2 — Good</b> <b>Description</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Light cosmetic wear from normal use</li> <li>Minor scratches or scuffs visible on close inspection</li> <li>No heavy dents, cracks, or significant blemishes</li> </ul>	B BB
<b>C3 — Fair</b> <b>Description</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Moderate cosmetic wear</li> <li>Visible scratches, scuffs, and/or moderate dents</li> <li>Wear is clearly noticeable</li> </ul>	C CX
<b>C4 — Poor</b> <b>Description</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Heavy cosmetic wear</li> <li>Large scratches, dents, discoloration, paint wear, or significant surface damage</li> <li>Appearance is substantially degraded</li> </ul>	D D-
